

Give Me a Hut

Traditional Australian Folksong. Game instructions by Deborah Smith.



Give me a hut in my own na-tive land, or a tent in the bush with the mount-ains so grand. I

don't care how far in the bush it may be. If there's one faith-ful friend that will share it with me.

(These actions can be used with any 3 metre song such as “Coffee”, “Edelweiss”, etc.)

Students sit in a single circle holding their hands out in front of the people beside them. Their left hand should face up under the person’s hand on their left and their right hand should face down on top of the person’s hand on the right.

On each beat for the first six beats, using your right hand, hit your neighbours left hand then your right knee, your left knee, under your left hand then clap on top of your left hand twice.

For the next six beats, using your left hand, hit your neighbours right hand then your left knee, your right knee, under your right hand then clap on top of your right hand twice. Repeat to end of song.
