

Strategy Step - Early Practice Activity 4 Aural Lesson Segment

Objective

Prerequisite Skills and Knowledge

Prior to beginning this activity, students should have successfully completed all Aural Preparation, Visual Preparation and Present Steps from the $\int \int \int Strategy$.

Activity: Clever Echo

Description: Teacher claps abstract (unknown) rhythmic patterns (without rhythm names) and the students clap back while aurally deriving (inner hearing) the rhythm names, then immediately repeat, saying the rhythm names.

Example Lesson Activities

- a. The teacher claps a four beat rhythm using only ↓ ↓ . e.g. ↓ ↓ . .
- b. Without pausing the beat, the students clap the rhythm back.
- c. Again without pausing the beat, the students clap the rhythm again, saying the rhythm names.

Extension Suggestions:

- skip step b. above
- extend the rhythm to six beats then eight beats long.
