Observations that could be included in an answer for the other element aption "e found below."

Texture

- the texture of this excerpt is mostly homophonic with piano and string accompaniment and vocal melody giving a feeling of tender sincerity
- various melodic lines arise from the texture, such as the female, pizes conter melody and occasional melodic phrases from the violin which introduces a sense of por, on time to time, heightening the reflective nature of the song's character
- the texture is fairly dense due to the sustain pedal blurring the south formula and the violin and cello playing in a similar register to the piano the density increasing in the south female and male voices are singing simultaneously with the accompaniment

Tone Colour

- tone colour of the piano is clear and rich which be well with the rich and sonorous sound of the violin
 and cello, helping to support the tender and signere reads
- the female voice is clear and bell-like, swelling the song a tender, reflective feel
- the tone colour of the male voice is quit ent and contrasting to the other instruments, being more breathy and rough with a less finessed out, all ling to the sincerity of the sound
